Biography

Marc-Antoine Granier is a sound artist, radio artist, composer and sound producer.

For more than twenty years, he has been recording and composing with all the sounds that pass through his instrument : the microphone.

His creations, in which intimate stories resonate with sounds, are at the crossroads of documentary, musical narration and sensitive writing. They explore the fragility of humanity, our relationship with the sound environment and our own stories. His work reflects a constant curiosity and a mixture of genres. For him, sound is a living material. His recordings, his sound recordings, in urban environments or elsewhere, give his writings on reality a transversal dimension, always shaping several paths of listening. He likes to make voices heard as a precious narrative, respectful of the encounters that pass through his microphone. A composer and musician, he also works in the fields of electronic music, sampling and concret music.

Radio remains a space for free and unrestrained expression ; it is a powerful vehicle for ideas and emotions.

For several years, he has been producing experimental and documentary audio pieces as a freelancer or for various French-language radio stations.

These include France Culture, where his creations have been broadcast in programmes such as Les Ateliers de la Nuit, Sur les Docks, Création on air and L'Expérience. He has also worked with RTBF (Belgium) and RTS (Switzerland). An activist for free radio, he co-produces collective programmes on Radio Canut in Lyon (MégaCombi, Micro Sieste, etc.).

He has been recognised for his creations Ville Souterraine (2019) and Total désir (2018) at the Phonurgia Awards, in the documentary and fiction categories respectively.

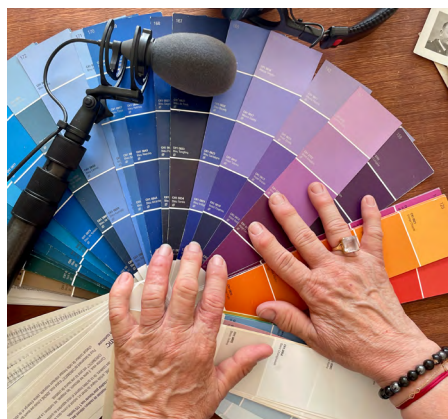
At the same time, he has collaborated with several theatre and street arts companies, including KomplexKapharnaüm, Éric Massé, Carole Thibaud, Angélique Clairant, Entre chien et Loup, etc., developing a practice nourished by in-situ staging, field encounters and the transmission of collective narratives.

He enjoys teaching others through participatory art workshops, focusing on listening skills, sound as a form of writing, and live radio broadcasting.

As a trainer and facilitator, he organizes and leads workshops and collaborates with various training organizations such as Phonurgia Nova (Arles), La Ciné Fabrique (Lyon), and Ardèche Images (Lussas).

His involvement in local projects has enabled him to work with a variety of audiences (elderly people, children, teenagers and/or people with disabilities). These projects, rich in human interaction, often take place in retirement homes, medical centres, schools and prisons. They have been carried out with institutions such as the OVE Foundation, the Lyon Opera House and the Saint-Étienne Opera House.

His radio plays : Entre les mères (Between Mothers, 2015), Total désir (Total Desire, 2018), Fragment magnétique (Magnetic Fragment, 2016), Ville Souterraine (2019), 23 Nuits (2021), D'immenses petits pas (2024), and Colorer la taule (2025) have been broadcast at festivals such as TyFilm festival, Les rencontres AD-HOC, festival Cinéma et psychiatrie, Festival Rien à voir, Tënk.ca, and Festival Les tombés de la Nuit.



The genesis of the [Seconde Pot](#) project:
In a city, around a wall, a muralist and a sound designer seek out leftover paint pots from residents.
They collect paint and gather stories. From this raw material, a hybrid work will be created: a visual and sound painting.

Seconde pot #3, a sound and visual project, is located in Rennes in the former Jacques Cartier prison.

Built in 1903 and closed in 2010, this prison is a place where many eras intersect and tell the story of detention.

Former prisoners, guards and prison workers shared their stories, their colours, their voices and their confidences with us.

All of them have a direct or indirect connection with imprisonment. Their memories are forever marked by this experience.

Huge Little Steps (documentary creation)

This creation was recorded over the course of a year. It follows the daily multidisciplinary work of a team of carers in a unit at Saint Jean de Dieu Hospital in Lyon.

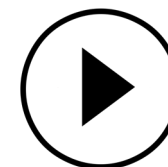
These carers work with very young autistic children and their families, both in hospital and at home. This documentary attempts to provide a more intimate account of the efforts made by these children to interact and engage in speech and communication through play and everyday gestures.

It takes time, patience, creativity, and a combination of all these ingredients to bring these voices to the fore.

Observing, listening, imitating, adjusting, and responding to meticulous work that is often overlooked and underappreciated.

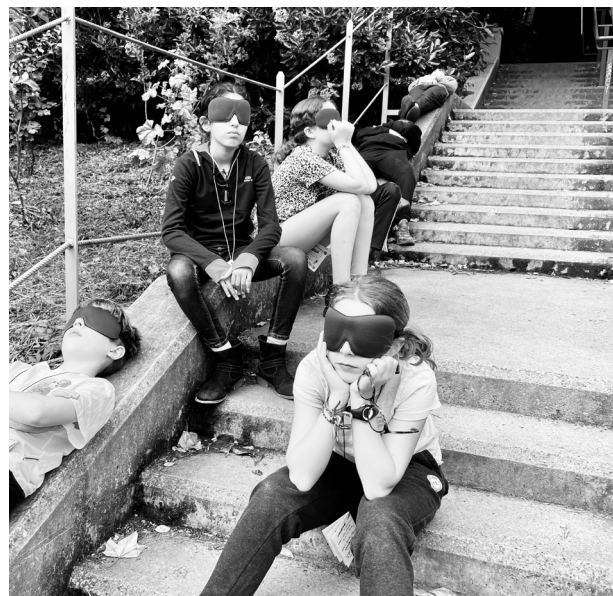
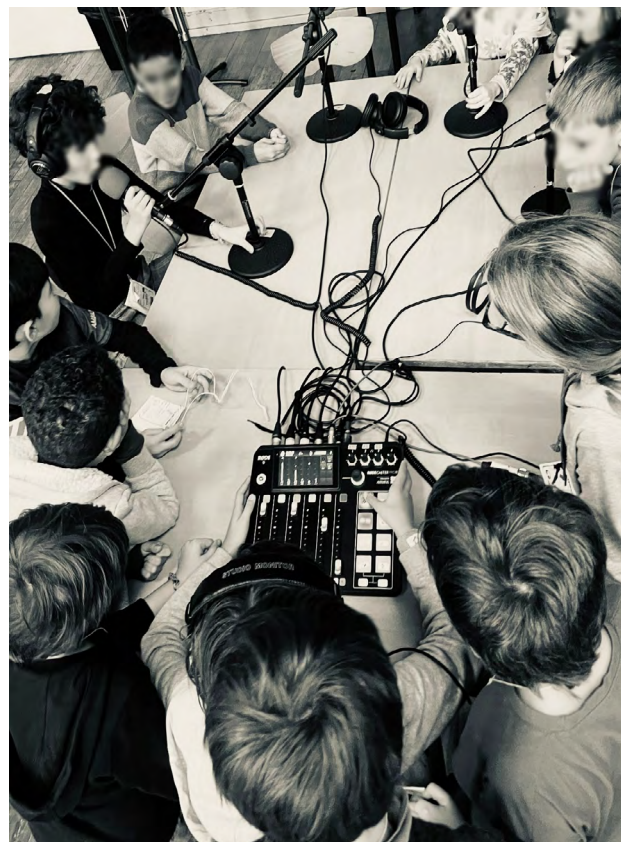
This radio essay aims to leave a trace, a unique and intimate recording, of the voices of these children, their families and their carers.

(school radio station)

Michel Info is a live radio station.
It is produced with the teaching staff of the Michel Servet school in Lyon's 1th borough.

Although it started with a single class for one year in 2022, it is now a three-year radio support and broadcasting project.
150 children and 8 teachers, 6 classes involved, from Year 6 to Year 10.

All programmes are recorded live and cover all forms of radio broadcasting: vox pops, dramas, columns, reports, radio games, sound effects, live music, playlists, etc.

Five to ten programmes per year.
This radio station also organises 'immersive weeks' throughout the school, dedicated to sound, radio and listening.

«From intimate voice to lyrical voice...»

Lyrical Correspondences is an intergenerational participatory art project combining sound and vocal workshops centred around one instrument: the voice.

Together, we wrote, spoke, recounted life stories and sang, based on the narrative framework of an opera.

The recordings were played back to us.

These (collective) playbacks were the very foundation of accepting our own voices in the face of a creative act.

These correspondences were transformed into spectacular public performances, as well as a series of audio postcards and radio creations.

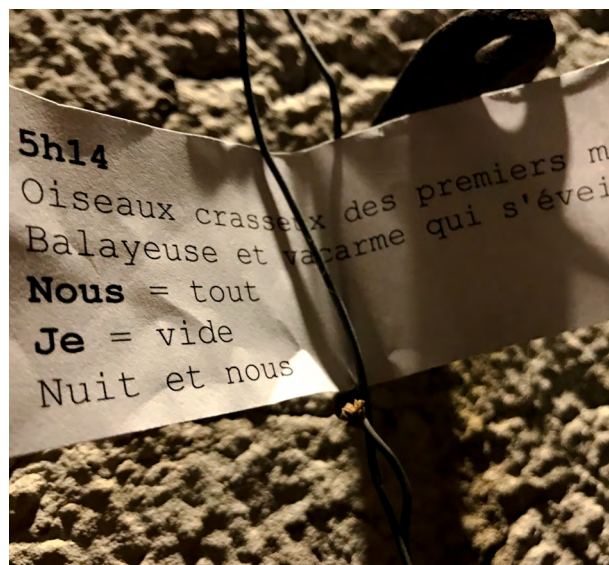

23 nights- Urban poetry of nocturnal fragments

Like the night itself, this creation is made up of fragments. Like diving into a jagged nocturne, like a desire to be alive at night.

« First, there were night-time outings in 2020 during lockdown and the first curfews. Wandering alone through the city, listening to the silence, I enjoyed the exhilarating contrast of finding myself in this 'world', allowing myself to be a listening witness.

But as the nights, streets and intersections went by, a feeling of terrible collective injustice gradually grew within me. I then set about recording the urban landscape, a task that would take a year to complete, in order to capture the essence of those nights.

In this radio essay, five characters wrote one, two or three texts at the end of each night. The nights passed. Words were written. They revealed intimate feelings, secrets, transformations, urban animals, the sounds of a vanished party...

23 Nights is the sum of the nights that unfold in this radio piece. »

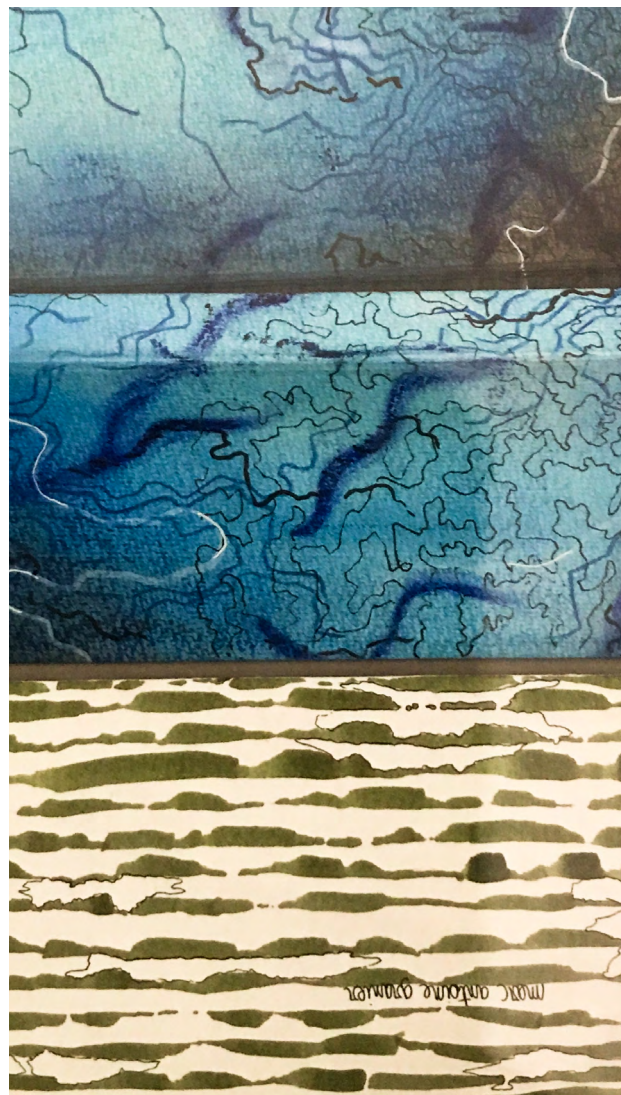

Silent Night - Books and sound creations

Silent Night is a synaesthetic experience combining sound and graphic design, created by the first-year Dnmade Reliure/Objet-livre class at the École supérieure Estienne-Paris, initiated and supervised by their teacher Sophie Bourly, with the theme: **Crossing a City at Night.**

Creation of nine book objects based on a series of five experimental and narrative sound pieces produced by Marc-Antoine Granier between March and June 2021.

Recording, composing and narrating the sounds of the city at night, then graphically exploring their metamorphoses through the imagination.

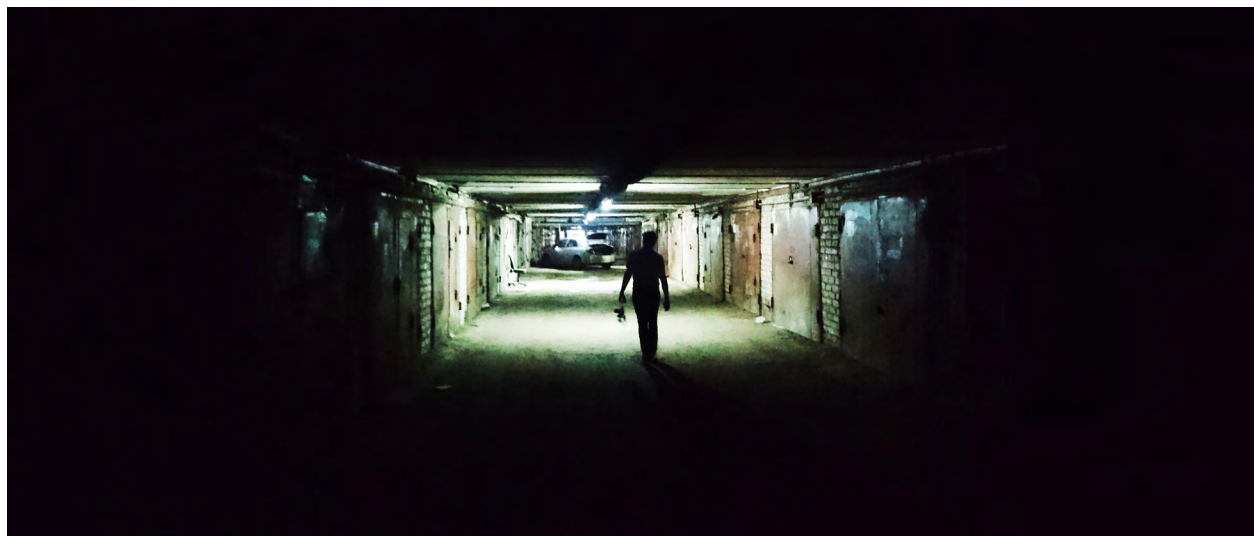

Subterranean City - Documentary creation

In Russia, there is a city within a city. It is called the «City of Garages». It is the result of a long journey that men have taken through the twists and turns of Sovietism. This city was born from the rubble.

The wind blew in the 1990s, pushing men and women from one world to another overnight, leaving them facing a supposed freedom. After the whole system broke down, these places, which were once designed for parking cars, became spaces for producing or repairing things, and then sometimes places where people ended up living...

The Garazhnik (garage dwellers) are the lifeblood of this city, its parallel economy and its artisanal hacking. Mutual aid and the instinct for survival have endured.

In this radio drama, the city is depicted in Moscow, but also in other cities further east, such as Naberezhnye Chelny in Tatarstan and Ulyanovsk on the banks of the Volga River.

The Imagined City - Poetic territory

La Ville Imaginée (The Imagined City) is a poetic and playful adventure that encourages us to see the city, make it our own, collectively imagine an urban composition and share it.

Reclaiming public space: together, we organised urban walks, sound walks and writing workshops over four weeks in the Guillotière/Gerland neighbourhood of Lyon.

Our footsteps trod the asphalt, our imaginations followed them and created collective narratives... Taking the time to look, listen to the space around us and transform the city.

These imaginings, in text, graphics and sound, gave rise to a two-part exhibition, in the Girondines nursing home and at the Jean Macé library (Lyon 7th borough).

Radio creation workshop

Between 1974 and 2005, Lucien Barou, a linguist from the Loire region, met with more than 160 veterans, mainly in the Loire department and the Forez mountains.

What started out as a simple project to collect audio recordings to support a linguistic thesis became something of an obsession. A act of *mémoire*.

He collected these men's testimonies, their experiences of the Great War.

A treasure trove of sound recorded using a tape recorder, amounting to over four hundred hours of recordings.

We met Lucien.

He played us his tapes. Those husky voices, those warm breaths, those distorted crackles.

This magnetic material, taken from his tape recorder, was the starting point for unravelling a certain past.

A past, recounted in the present tense, which Lucien still carries with him today.

Mémento

Show creation

«*Mémento* is a public statement in the city, addressing the themes of collective and individual resistance.

The city is the natural setting for fiction – the murals are created based on typical locations: public facilities, shops, homes, alleyways, etc.

The dramaturgy is constructed along the route connecting the murals.

Soon, along this route, spaces are taken over.

Agents neutralise sections of walls: façades covered with kraft paper and printed images, which will serve as backgrounds for the murals.

One evening, commandos descend on the neighbourhood to carry out acts of sabotage: creating lasting murals using images, sounds, collages and graffiti. A series of 'commemorative plaques' is revealed on the walls, continuing to question passers-by and residents about the resistance movements of yesterday and today..»

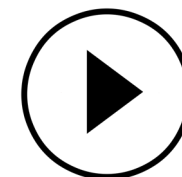

From dusk till dawn, prostitutes share their memories and stories with us.

These sound portraits form the raw material for a creation that uses the architecture of the Galerie des Terreaux as its backdrop.

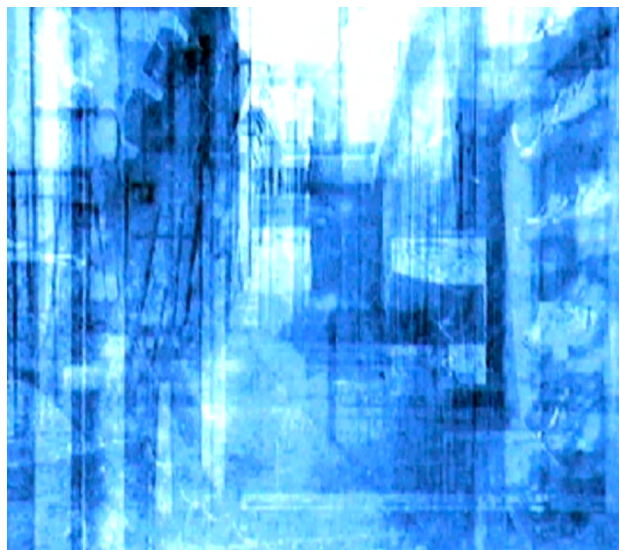
As the words intertwine, a mobile, nocturnal urban landscape is projected onto the walls of the gallery's façade.

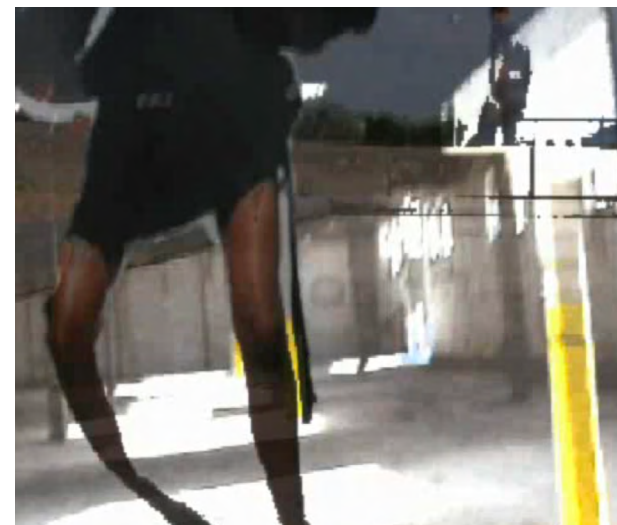
Between 2001 and 2003, Marc-Antoine Granier collaborated with several visual artists and video-graphers.

Experiments that allowed him to work with sound art and electronic music through video and photographic creations.

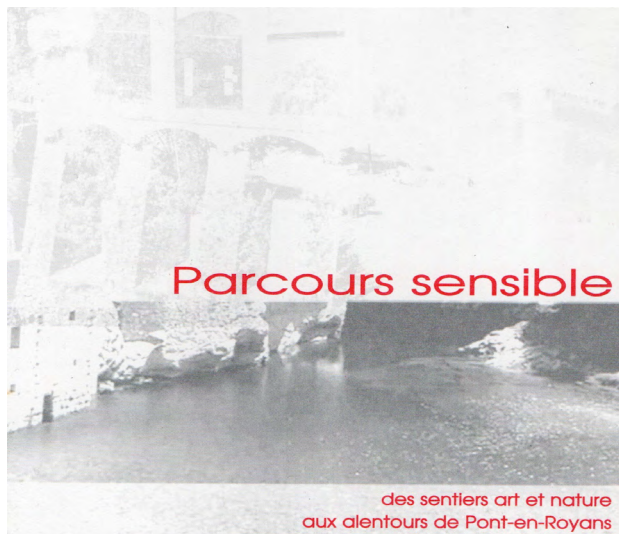
